OUR EFFORTS SO FAR AND APPEAL

Respected Sir's /Madam,

Kindly find herewith our Profile Booklet which covers our efforts to uplift needy families through Higher Educational Empowerment to their brilliant children after their excellent result in 12th standard for their college studies for either Degree Engineering/ Architect or MBBS or Chartered Accountant studies.

We give our financial support for the shortfall amount with the funds contributed by our kind and Generous Donors.

(1) Eligibility Criteria for our support are:

(i) Family's maximum annual income of Rs.3 lacs.

(ii) In 12th std., the student. Should have scored minimum 75% marks or more and has secured admission in colleges approved by us where campus jobs are maximum.

(2) No. of students supported so far by is 1491 nos. of who have completed their Graduation plus 344 nos. are presently studying their Graduation course and 179 are doing post-Graduation so, totally 2014 nos. of students are supported so far by us.

(3) Support Amount Disbursed to above 2014 students so far is Rs. 25 Crores.

(4) Average Amount required presently to support one student for their Graduation course of 4 to 4.5 years is Rs.2.4 lacs.

(5) By now out of those who have completed their course, 99.12 % of them have been employed.

(6) We are giving interest free refundable loan as our support which they need to return with reasonable instalments and our loan recovery is excellent at 95%.

(7) (i) The analysis of family income of 77.33% of students supported is below Rs. 1.5 lacs per annum against Rs.3 lacs specified by us.

(iii) 77.35 % of our selected students had scored marks between 80 to 95 %.

Preamble :

There are really Brilliant Students scoring more than 70% marks in class 12th in spite of having studied in ordinary schools and not having good facilities. These students can get admission in Engineering, Pharmacy, Computer / Software, Medical etc., but due to very low income, their parents cannot impart higher education to them. Our activity is to financially and mentally support such students so that they can become Engineers, Doctors etc., and uplift their families.

OUR MISSION:

To Perpetually UPLIFT Downtrodden/Needy Families by supporting their Brilliant and Determined children for their Higher Education in Professional Courses in Universities, mainly, Degree Engineering, Medicine and Chartered Accountancy.

Our Vision:

The benefits of the trust shall be open to all irrespective of caste, creed, gender or religion. Without in any way limiting the generality of the main objects. The objects of the trust are to provide and to undertake the shortfall in the payment of costs directly and indirectly related to providing opportunities to individuals from weaker, poor, needy and underprivileged sections of public in India without any distinction to obtain higher education at university and / or equivalent educational institution in India, including –

- To institute studentships, scholarships, stipends, medals, prize etc. And award the same.
- To help and encourage / motivate, deserving students and to provide monetary and Other assistance to students / scholars for pursuing their higher education / / further study and to continuously monitor / guide them for their success apart from providing monetary assistance.
- To do all that is necessary and incidental for the purpose of achieving the objects mentioned above

Accounts & Auditing of HEST:-

- (1) We also get our accounts audited every year by Chartered Accountant. This is also required by Charity Commissioner and Income Tax authorities and also FCRA authorities.

The Potential / The need for this activity.

- ❑ Std.XII is very crucial for students, as the result of STD XII is the basis on which they get admission for Higher Education in colleges.
- ❑ In Gujarat more than 5,00,000 students appear for STD XII (all streams). General/Commerce stream students have limited scope for Professional Course except they take up courses like CA, CS, and MBA etc. Whereas Science Stream Students about 1,20,000 nos per year with good marks can get admission for Engineering, IT, Computer, Pharmacy, Medicine, Dental, Physiotherapy etc
- ❑ In STD XII (Science), results @ 30,000 students pass with first class and above grades.
- ❑ We have observed that there, are many very low income (less than Rs 1,80,000 per year) group families. There are more than 500 science stream students every year who are very brilliant but cannot undertake higher studies though they can secure admission in good Engineering, medical or other high potential courses, as their parents cannot afford expenses to provide them college education.
- ❑ There are two types of colleges, 1) Govt/Grant-in Aid Colleges & 2) Self Financed Colleges.
- ❑ The Self Financed Colleges, charges annual fees of Rs 80,000 to Rs 3,00,000 and above.
- ❑ (Earlier we were specifying max family income as Rs. 300,000 per year.)

Methodology of selection of needy students:

- (1) We work at the moment for Gujarat based students as it is difficult to cope up with all of Needy Brilliant students of even Gujarat alone, considering large funds required.
- (2) We do not distinguish between caste, creed, class, gender, community etc. and only criteria is brilliance and real financial hardship of the parents.

Identification of such students: -

- (a) Every year, we write to large number of Higher Secondary School in Gujarat, to send list (with contact details) of Brilliant Needy students and than we send details of our loan scholarship to these student to apply if they are eligible and we actually get good no of applications due to these efforts from very Brilliant / Needy students.
 - (b) We also insert advertisements in main Gujarati News papers after 12th results are announced, seeking applications from such students.
 - (c) We obtain list of A1/A2 Grade students from GSHSEB which they have agreed because of the purpose.
- (3) After getting names and address we obtain extensive details by sending forms which includes proof of income, copies of results etc.
 - (4) We then select brightest and poorest students out of applications received and its number depends on funds available. If funds available are to induct 50 new students we select about 100 nos. of students for paying visits to their residences to verify written details furnished and to assess real need.
 - (5) We generally do not finance 100% of their expenses but do it as per short fall amount required and max about 90%.
 - (6) The disbursement of funds is based on reimbursement against proof furnished of their expenditure, within sanctioned amount.
 - (7) The financial assistance is on loan basis and recovery to commence after one year of their completion of course / earning commences. The agreements are signed by scholar. We however will take practical approach for recovery based on earnings and condition of the students' family.

Follow up with our Scholars during their College studies:-

- (1) We continuously get copies of various tests/exams given by students and monitor the status of their studies.
- (2) We have appointed honorary mentors at various places to
 - a. Assist and motivate students.
 - b. To continuously remind them to be successful and uplift their families, help others also.
 - c. To keep good health.
 - d. To keep good friend circle.
 - e. If there is English language problem to work on it by attending classes etc.
- (3) We also try to remain in touch by phones, meeting them etc.
- (4) We regularly organize review/interaction meetings at main places where large no of our scholars are studying.

Source of funds:

From kind Donors of the country and abroad. By Dec 25, we have disbursed Rs. 25 crores to 2014 no. of scholars.

Periodical Review/Interaction Meetings with our Scholars

We organize Periodical Review Meetings with the group of student studying at various locations like Surat, Ahmedabad, Anand/ VV Nagar etc where our students are studying.

Such Periodical Review Meetings provide an opportunity to understand the difficulties faced by the students and accordingly in guiding and counseling them. During such meeting we also arrange talks by some eminent speakers /motivators

Summary of our Activity:

- 1)** Higher Education Support Trust was established on 31st July 2006, for Supporting Higher/ college Education of needy bright students who have mainly passed 12th (science) with excellent result for ultimate goal to uplift family of needy students.
- 2)** For source of finance it was decided to approach institutions, corporates and individuals etc. for Donations.
- 3)** First batch of scholars was inducted in 2006 and then every year no of Scholars are being inducted depending on availability of funds by now till 2025-26, we have inducted 2014 no. of Brilliant / Needy Students for our Financial & Motivational Support.
- 4)** We mainly provide shortfall amount of students with max amount at present of Rs. 70000=00 per student per year and we provide funds by 6 monthly installments after examining semester results.
- 5)** None of our scholars have taken Drop or failed. As per the last performance Analysis,
 - 6.87% of student have secured above 90%marks.
 - 17.47% of student have secured 80 to 89%marks.
 - 16.90% of student have secured 70 to 79%marks.
 - 44.98% of student have secured 60 to 69%marks.
 - 13.75% of student have secured Below 60%marks.
- 6)** (a) By now as on Dec 2025, 1491 scholars have completed studies and 523 are studying.
(b) Our scholars have mainly done Degree Engineering, Medical & CA as follows:
Degree Engineering: 1241 nos.
MBBS: 590 nos.
Other Medical Courses: 157 nos.
CA: 26 nos.

7) Share and Care Foundation-USA have contributed largest amount of Donation to us. Our other Donors of good amount are Viram Foundation-USA, Adani Group

of cos, Cadila Pharma, Our Founder Donor Sri Bharat Amin, Sri Rohit Doshi, Sri Aroon Doshi, Sri Vijaybhai, Sri Kamlesh Udani and many other Donors to whom we and our Scholars are extremely indebted and grateful.

8) We make immense efforts to identify students with excellent results & Minimum annual income of their families e.g. in 2025-26;

Marks Scored:

60% of students inducted Scored 81 to 100% Marks in 12th.

85.33% of Students inducted Scored 71 to 100% Marks in 12th

Family Income:

22.67% of student's families had annual income upto Rs.1,00,000=00

77.34 % of student's families had annual income upto Rs.1,50,000=00

9) Starting salaries (Rs per year) of our Scholars:

- i) Between Rs. 15 lacs up to Rs. 91 lacs: 50 nos.
- ii) Between Rs. 7 lacs up to Rs. 15 lacs: 155 nos.
- iii) Between Rs. 5 lacs up to Rs. 7 lacs: 135 nos.
- iv) Between Rs. 3 lacs up to Rs. 5 lacs: 242 nos.
- v) Up to Rs. 3 lacs: 803 nos.

Normally, even cos like L & T, Infoys, TCS and many other cos give starting annual salary between Rs. 3 to 5 lacs.

10) We have so far disbursed Rs. 25 Crores to our inducted students for their studies.

You may agree that students being selected are from very Needy Families and with inadequate facilities, also they have scored very high Score in 12th. Their Family income are also Low.

Those who have graduated, have good Starting salaries also.

History of Trust's Activity:-

The activity in the first year (2006-07) of the establishment of this Trust. :-

In March 2006, we conceived this activity and firmed up our mind to focus our work in this slot which has excellent potential to uplift large no of families by way of financially and motivationally to support very brilliant students, hailing from financially very weak families and so, their children though obtain 70/80/90% plus marks in class 12 (Science) and can obtain

admissions in degree courses in Engineering, Medical etc., they cannot get them educated because of their not being able to afford the expenses.

We observed that if such brilliant students get educated by our financial support within about 4-5 years, they will be able to become Engineers or Doctors etc. and then would be able to earn good income and UPLIFT their families.

We therefore inserted small advertisement in the local newspapers inviting applications for such students and their parents who would appear in class 12 examinations in March 06. Against our press advertisement, we got applications from 116 brilliant students.

We selected 55 out of 116 applications based on the most brilliant and the most needed ones. We interviewed them and selected 42 students who extremely deserved the support.

We then, made synopsis of about 38 students and sent to our friends etc. with a letter of appeal to consider helping as many students as possible. Based on the positive response received from various donors, we could extend financial assistance in the first year of our commencement of this activity, to 38 students.

The Second Year (2007-08) of the activity: -

Since, normally annual exams of 12th are held in March of every year and the activity of the trust had commenced in March 06, we did not have much time to obtain all Gujarat statistics for selection of the first batch of students appeared for exams in March 06 and depended more response to our press Advertisement.

However, after the work for the selection of the first batch was completed, we got in touch with Directors of Education of each District of Gujarat and got the list of High Schools and obtained List of needy Students.

In the second year of our activity, considering 38 students to be taken care of the first year and availability of funds, we gave scholarships to 14 fresh students in 2007-08 who had secured excellent marks in March 07 exam of 12th and were hailing from very needy families.

The Third year of (2008-09) of the activity of the Trust. :

We were all the time trying to get funds from more donors so that in the Third year, we can induct more students and also take care of $34 + 14 = 48$ existing scholars as we have to help each student for 4 to 5 years of their full course. It was heartening that with the help of Share and Care Foundation, we got excellent commitment from Dr. Doshis of New York and locally by Adani

Group and Cadila Group, we were in a position to induct much large no of fresh students as our scholars.

We made extensive scrutiny of these applications, got details in our proforma, got details of admissions secured etc. Large no of our matured volunteers and mentors visited residences of almost 200 selected applicants based on their merit and means.

We meticulously prepared tabulations of these students along with visit reports and have finally released fresh scholarships to as much as 93 students.

Now there are $38 + 14 + 93 = 145$ students who are getting financial support from us for their higher studies.

The fourth year of our activity (2009-10):-

Similarly, when in May 2009, the result of 12th (Science) was declared, next day, we had advertised and written to large no of Schools to identify Brilliant but needy students. This time, we had increased the eligibility of minimum marks by 5% as compared to last year, we had received 419 applications and we sanctioned scholarships to 92 nos only as per funds, we could mobilize.

The fifth year of our activity (2010-11):-

In 2010-11 also, we had received large no, of applications against which we could induct 42 nos of fresh scholars as per availability of funds.

The sixth year of our activity (2011-12):-

In 2011-12, we had received approximate. 444 applications out of which we have inducted 186nos of fresh scholars. Thus, by now, we have inducted 468nos of students as our scholars.

The Seventh year of our activity (2012-13):-

In 2012-13, we have further inducted 114 fresh students. Thus total no of students as our scholars work out as $468 + 114 = 582$ nos.

The Eight year of our activities (2013-14):-

In 2013-14, we had received over 411 applications out of which we have inducted 74 nos of fresh scholars making total of $579+74=653$ nos to whom we are supporting for their Higher Studies.

The Ninth year of our activities (2014-15):-

In 2014-15, we had received over 556 applications out of which we have inducted 75 nos of fresh scholars making total of $651+75=726$ nos to whom we are supporting for their Higher Studies.

The Tenth year of our activities (2015-16) :-

In 2015-16, we had received over 600 applications out of which we have inducted 162 nos of fresh scholars.

- Against our Press Advertisements, letters to over several Schools, and to students who obtained A1 & A2 Grade, we have received approx 600 applications this year.
- Detailed scrutiny was done of these applications and 200 best applications were selected for visits to residences of these students.
- Based on Merit, Income & Visit Reports, we have sanctioned our interest free loans to 159 nos of worthy students.

We have 157 nos of fresh scholars, The Analysis of 154 nos of fresh students inducted is as follows: -

It can be seen that 25% of Scholars inducted have scored above 90% and 59% have scored above 80 % marks in 12th science.

All these 154 nos of fresh scholars have secured admissions in Gujarat's top most, reputed colleges as approved by us in Degree Engineering stream having excellent record of placement in good companies even in slowdown period and due to establishment large no of new colleges, resulting in much higher supply than Demand. Subject: Most Critical Mile-stone of your Life: college campus Job Interviews.

Dear Scholars of HEST, inducted in 2020-21,

You are now studying in the 7th semester which is last year of your Degree Engineering studies.

You will have campus Interviews for Jobs in semester 7th & 8th you may be aware that the fresh jobs availability in the country is not satisfactory and reputed companies recruit fresh Engineers only through campus Interviews which they take in their certain Approved colleges only. It is therefore very important and critical that you must secure a Job in companies coming in your college as off-campus, Job availability is scarce and very difficult to get.

You also must be aware that companies take campus interview in following manner:-

- I. Aptitude Test which is normally not taught in your Engineering course but some colleges are giving training for it by external tutors. Generally, students learn Aptitude Test from “Quantitative Aptitude “book of Dr R.S.Agarwal. This book is available in Amazon India, online.
- II. Written test on your Engineering subjects and on Aptitude. Also coding test for IT/Computer students.
- III. Group Discussions : In this, students need to participate lively which is possible if you develop good communication skill and
 - a. Reasoning on the topic, to be aware of current affairs / Topics etc.
 - b. Participating, body language.
 - c. Expressing in short time (Time Management)
 - d. Presentation (Articulate)
 - e. Summarizing
 - f. Creativity
 - g. Listening
 - h. Proactive
 - i. Be Analytical
 - j. Practice public Speaking

You can make a group of 4/5/6 of your college friends and practice for Group Discussions. Lot of hints are also available in the internet also.

- IV. Oral personal interview mainly for HR / Personnel matters. You should take Guidance from your placement officer and seniors to perform better in the campus Interviews and secure a Job.

V. It is observed that in spite of studying in the Best-reputed colleges, some students fail to secure a job in college campus. This will be tremendously PAINFUL matter like Paradise lost. You must make serious & sincere preparation for campus Interviews

Sometimes, some students have some preference for a particular type of job like Marketing, Production, Planning, R & D etc but it is better to not to attach yourself for a particular branch as there is scope of development in all branches and department if you are sincere.

One thing is to be kept in mind that if you fail to get Job in campus interview in your college, it would be difficult for you to get any good Job off- campus and you will have to compromise for second Grade Job with low salaries.
